Pet Consumables Systems Readiness Checklist

Review ingredient lots, finished batches, expiration, label versions, market status, Shopify, Chewy, marketplace demand, subscriptions and traceability.

Ingredients and batches

- ☐ Capture supplier ingredient lot and receipt identity.
- ☐ Preserve actual component consumption in each finished batch.
- ☐ Track finished lot, yield, expiration and location.
- ☐ Link supplier evidence without moving approval authority into Fishbowl.

Product and market data

- ☐ Name the approved source for formula and guaranteed-analysis data.
- ☐ Link finished SKU and lot to the effective label version.
- ☐ Surface state-market status and renewal dates as client-owned gates.
- ☐ Maintain unique SKU, UPC and pack identity across channels.

Channels, subscriptions and trace

- ☐ Allocate only eligible, sufficiently dated inventory across Shopify, Chewy, marketplaces and retail demand.
- ☐ Document Chewy item, pack, order, acknowledgment, shipment, invoice and inventory requirements before designing the interface.
- ☐ Calculate variety-pack availability from components.
- ☐ Test backward and forward trace with controlled data.
- ☐ Keep recall decisions and notifications with authorized personnel.

Architecture and ownership

- ☐ Name the system of record for product, inventory, order, fulfillment, quality and finance data.
- ☐ Label every connection as documented, partner-supported or designed after discovery.
- ☐ Document field-level ownership for identifiers, status, quantity, dates and prices.
- ☐ Assign a business owner and technical owner to every interface.

Validation and support

- ☐ Define valid, warning and rejected transaction states.
- ☐ Make failed handoffs visible before a customer or partner reports them.
- ☐ Test with controlled non-production data and reconcile expected results.
- ☐ Document cutover, monitoring, issue response, change control and rollback.
