☐	Ingredient lot OAT-ING-7741 received on RCV-88214 from Northfield Ingredients.
☐	Packaging lot CTN-22091 received on RCV-88176 from Harbor Packaging.
☐	WO-10482 consumed both lots and produced 510 cases of OAT-0826-A.
☐	Finished lot reference includes yield, date, facility and approved-status link.

Forward trace

☐	312 cases remain in WH-A; 88 cases are allocated across four open orders.
☐	420 cases shipped across six orders with shipment and customer references.
☐	A second finished lot, OAT-0826-B, also consumed ingredient lot OAT-ING-7741.
☐	Authorized personnel would review disposition, release and recall decisions.
